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DISCOVER OUR HISTORY

We are a family winery from Galicia with more than **60 hectares of albariño vineyards** in the **Salnés Valley** in the **Rías Baixas** region. We pour all our expertise, scientific knowledge and humanity into growing albariño grape.

We are a **small family winery**, firmly committed to **quality**, **sustainability and internationalization**. We have the capacity to produce around **400,000** bottles of albariño.

We seek international recognition. Nowadays, Adegas Terra de Asorei's albariños are available in more than **20 countries**.

Terra de Asorei's logo is a visual poem. It is made up of A's, reminiscent of the families from the Salnés Valley with a long-standing winemaking tradition dating back to 1953, when the first Albariño Wine Festival was held in Cambados.



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We want to engage in dialogue with the great wines of the world with our Terra de Asorei, an authentic and honest Albariño. The Terra de Asorei logo is a symbolic poem of six "A's":

A Adega (The Winery), Albariño, Authentic, Atlantic Art with Love.

Wine description

Asorei is produced with 100% albariño grape from the Salnés Valley, mainly from **small-scale plantations in Cambados**. Cambados, the **Capital of Albariño** and of the Salnés county, was not only the first location to grow albariño vines, but also the first to start tasting, selling and marketing this wine variety in 1953.

Asorei remains true to this **heritage**, to traditional know-how and to the appreciation for the richness of the albariño grape. We created this fruity, tasty, palatable albariño in the **municipality of Cambados** to honour the winemaking and wine tasting tradition of this town in the Salnés Valley (Rías Baixas).

Bright and clean, with a beautiful straw-lemon yellow colour.



The Nose

It is fresh and lively, with particularly noticeable stone fruit aromas.



The Palate

There is a good balance between the acidity and the alcohol. Its finish is dominated by a nice acidity and notes of green apple and stone fruits.

Wine description

Terra de Asorei is produced with 100% albariño grape from the Salnés Valley, and aged on its lees for 6 months. **We work our vines as the sculptor works the stone**. Experience, science, soul and humanity are the chisels we use to carve our vines into art made wine: Terra de Asorei.

Cambados, the **Capital of Albariño**, is a land of great sculptors who took Galician wood and stone to the **universal art scene**, same as we want Terra de Asorei's authentic albariños to be on par with the most well-renowned wines in the world.

Terra de Asorei presents a beautiful straw-yellow color with greenish reflections.



The Nose

On the nose, the notes are aromatic herbs, dill, laurel, balsamy, citrus fruits (grapefruit and lemon), tropical (flat peach), stone fruits and peach.



The Palate

Fresh, fat, and quite sweet. Once more, we find notes of citrus and stone fruits.

Private Selection

Wine description

The Terra de Asorei Private Selection albariño epitomizes the combination of tradition and innovation that defines the **fellowship of winemaking families that is our winery**. The result is this delightful experience, full of organoleptic nuances.

Xosé Ramón "Roque" Durán, Chairman of Adegas Terra de Asorei, was the one to present to the Plenary Session of the Rías Baixas Regulatory Council the idea to create a new competition that would honour and foster the tradition of **bottling albariño** 12 months after production, a practice that allows its nuances to evolve throughout the years.

The Appearance

Deep straw yellow colour, with subtle golden hues



The Nose

High-intensity. It shows notes of aromatic herbs, balsamy, ripe stone fruits (apricot and medlar), with echoes of its ageing on lees (subtle spongecake, marzipan and toasted aromas) and a salty aftertaste.



The Palate

On the mouth, it is fresh, fat, mouth-coating, well-balanced and creamy, with ripe citrus fruit notes. It presents a mineral flavour and a long finish.

Wine description

Terra de Asorei Barrica is produced with grapes from small-scale plantations in the Salnés Valley (Galicia, Spain). The highly attentive care these grapes receive brings out the varietal character of albariño wine, which we elegantly complement with notes of wood.

This wine **is aged in oak barrels for 6 months**, as small family wineries in the Salnés Valley used to do up until 1980. We have now revived this tradition and enhanced it with reinfoced knowledge, care and rigour. Terra de Asorei Barrica is a special, **limited edition** with less than **2.667 bottles**.

Lemon-yellow of medium depth.



The Nose

Medium-high intensity. Dominated by notes of new barrel, but maintaining the varietal character of albariño. Background notes of citrus fruits



The Palate

An enveloping wine with noticeable legs and a well-integrated acidity. The notes of wood become apparent once more in the retronasal flavour.

Wine description

The Finca de Ouso da Torre, together with the Torre de San Sadurniño, marked the boundaries of a demarcation that gave rise to what is now the town of Cambados, the Capital of Albariño. Historical records show that vineyards have been cultivated on this estate since 1524, and since 1843, Albariño vines have been identified as native to the area. Documents and family tradition from the Pintos lineage confirm that Albariño vines existed in Ouso da Torre even before 1902.

This estate, covering just over one hectare, was one of the largest and oldest in the Val do Salnés region. It was also one of the sites visited by scientists from the University of Santiago de Compostela (USC), the Spanish National Research Council (CSIC), and the regional government of Galicia to develop an in-vitro clone base for Albariño. This initiative aimed to ensure the authenticity and origin of the variety, as well as to support the region's winemaking tradition, which contributed to the creation of the Rías Baixas Designation of Origin. Today, more than two hundred century-old vines remain on this estate, along with a dozen more in the Igrexario de Xil in Meaño.

This wine is produced with full traceability, from these century-old vines to their harvest and vinification in the winery. After aging for a year on its own lees, it is bottled and then matured in the bottle, only being released for consumption two years after the harvest. Terra de Asorei Cepas Centenarias 2023 is a limited edition of 1,950 numbered bottles.

Espadeiro

Wine description

Espadeiro is a unique Galician grape that Adegas Terra de Asorei aims to revive with a limited production, sourced from vines over 50 years old in Cambados and Padrenda-Meaño. Described as a "Celtic wine" by poet Ramón Cabanillas in 1917, Espadeiro was the emblematic variety of the Salnés Valley since the 18th century, renowned for its quality and prestige. However, from 1960 onward, its production declined due to its complex cultivation and winemaking process.

Terra de Asorei reaffirms its **commitment to wine diversity** and tradition, combining modern techniques to create an authentic and elegant Espadeiro.

The Appearance

Medium-depth garnet colour with a violet rim



The Nose

High-intensity, dominated by berries (strawberry, raspberry, blackberry) and light milky (malolactic) and vanilla notes.



The Palate

With a soft attack, the acidity is well integrated into the alcohol, resulting in a smooth, harmonious, fullbodied wine with a long aftertaste and an elegant finish.

Wine description

Terra de Asorei Brut is a graceful, bubbly albariño explosion. It is produced with 100% albariño grape from the Salnés Valley (Rías Baixas) and aged in stacks on its lees for approximately 18 months.

The quality, juice and acidity of the very first grapes of the harvest are the backbone of this sparkling wine produced with albariño grapes according to the champenoise method. An amusement brought to you from Galicia, a first-class brut wine waiting to be discovered.

The Appearance

Straw yellow colour with greenish glints. The carbonic gas continuously sheds fine, persistent bubbles, like rosary beads.



The Nose

On the nose it is youthful and lively, with a nice level of intensity and echoes of pastries and spongecake. As it slowly opens up, new notes of aromatic herbs and white fruit arise.



The Palate

On the mouth, it has just the right amount of carbonic gas and acidity, making it fresh, vibrant and lively. Its finish leaves an excellent impression, and its residual sugar makes it rounder and more balanced.

Wine description

The fine bubbles of Brut Nature Terra de Asorei faithfully convey the freshness and authenticity of albariño wine. This is albariño sparkling wine taken to its highest form: made from 100% albariño grape from the Salnés Valley and aged in stacks on its lees for 24 months.

Terra de Asorei Brut Nature is a high-quality sparkling wine made with the very first grapes of the harvest, and produced according to the traditional champenoise method. With its superb quality and its genuine albariño flavour, our Nature will amaze those palates that are eager for new wine tasting experiences.



Wine description

Nai e Señora ("Mother and Lady") is a young albariño wine. It is produced with 100% albariño grape from the Salnés Valley, with its distinct elegance, structure and salinity, lent to it by the marine influence of the Ría de Arousa sea. It evolves very nicely during its first three years of life. Its label features the silhouette of a woman in a dress with motifs evoking a vineyard in the spring, or in the autumn just before the harvest.

The woman stands tall with her ponytail fluttering in the wind, symbolizing her empowerment, and next to her there is a butterfly, embodying her freedom.

Medium-high intensity. Notes of aromatic herbs, mint, citrus fruits, tropical fruits (lychees), Bartlett pears and apples.

Wine description

Nai e Señora "on its lees" is an evolution on our Nai albariño. The effect of the lees adds body personality to this albariño, making it rounder and more complex on the nose. Its fascinating evolution on the bottle is proof that time enhances the characteristics of Salnés Valley albariño grape and that it evolves nicely as time goes by, allowing a good wine-tasting experience in the 2nd or 3rd year.

Inspired by the freedom of the butterfly in its flight, we audaciously present this Nai albariño in red, hoping to unveil new ways of enjoying this wine.

The Nose

It is complex on the nose, with a prevalence of varietal notes (citrus fruits, stone fruits, etc.), notes of fines herbes and a mineral background.



The Palate

It has a wonderful balance between acidity and sugar and a long aftertaste. With an enveloping attack, there are strong varietal notes of albariño grape in its retronasal flavour



Acios de Galicia 2024 (Silver)



White wine aged in French oak barrels for 6 months

Wine description

This Albariño has been selected for aging due to its characteristics, spending **three months** in oak barrels to enhance its complexity while preserving its Salnés Valley varietal identity. The Nai Collection seeks new sensibilities, allowing the wine to evolve elegantly over five years.

With a limited edition of 1,333 bottles, it invites a slow tasting experience, exploring the harmony between Albariño and oak. Crafted with modern techniques and traditional aging, it follows the legacy of family-made Albariños, now sent out into the world to be enjoyed on special occasions.

Wine description

In our search for an out-of-the-ordinary experience, we have combined one of the finest grapes in the world, Salnés Valley albariño grape, with one of the highest-quality sparkling wine production processes, the Champenoise method. This combination results in the elegant bubbles of Brut Nai, erupting after 12 to 15 tranquil months of horizontal storage for its second fermentation.

Brut Nai is an invitation to discover how complex the albariño grape can be on the nose while having a good balance between sugar and acidity on the palate. The handsome design of the bottle perfectly conveys the elegance of its bubbles. This sparkling wine is the perfect choice to delight in the joy of sharing when you are feeling in harmony.

Dominated by the varietal notes of Salnés Valley albariño, it leaves a pastry impression due to the horizontal storage period. Medium intensity.

"Pazo" is the name given to traditional Galician stately homes.

The Pazo Torrado was built
during the second half os the 17th century.

At the beginning of the 21st century, it was refurbished, but its original structure and its distinctive gardens were preserved. It is located in the town of Cambados, where every summer since 1953 awards are bestowed on the finest albariño wines.

Wine description

The natural attributes and the aromatic richness of Salnés Valley albariño grape inspired us to produce a sparkling wine following the **traditional champenoise method**. After 10 years of work, we proudly present 1953 Pazo Torrado Brut. Alongside other wineries, we aim to renew the albariño industry. The first Albariño Wine Festival in 1953 marked the start of its commercialization after years of preservation by small family wineries.

In 2015, when our winemaking fellowship began producing wine under the label Adegas Terra de Asorei, we decided to mark the occasion by selecting the **very first grapes of the harvest**, which, **after 9 months of ageing in stacks**, have now become the basis for this sparkling albariño.




The Palate
